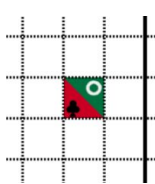
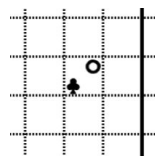
Symbols Explanation

Full Cross Stitch

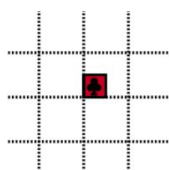
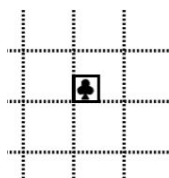


$\frac{3}{4}$ Stitch pair

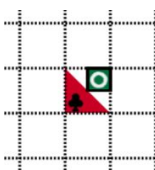
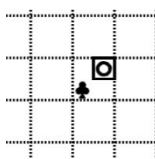


Quarter Stitch

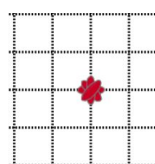
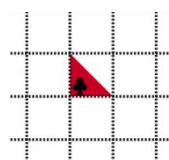
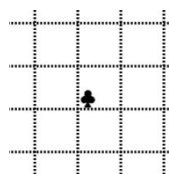
Note that the symbol is surrounded by a square
