



Space Dance

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Construction Guide

To achieve the effect of the stitching escaping the hoop, the pattern is stitched on two different mediums; 14 count aida, and 14 count perforated paper, preferably both of the same colour. Alternatively, the piece can be stitched just on fabric and mounted normally if you're not wanting the effect. Either way, don't stitch the pink stitches that are only there for reference (the circle being where the hoop will go)

Equipment

14 count aida (dark blue)

14 count perforated paper (dark blue)

6 inch hoop

Scissors

Stitching

The left side of the pattern should ONLY be stitched on the perforated paper. Make sure that when you stitch it, you leave enough room on the perforated paper for the area that will be stitched on both paper and fabric.

The right side of the pattern should ONLY be stitched on the aida fabric. It's best to leave the stitches next to the point you switch from just fabric to paper and fabric until you've stitched the paper and fabric together. This is so that you can hide the edge of the paper underneath stitches.



Line up the paper and the aida, and stitch the middle section of the pattern through BOTH the paper and the fabric. Make sure that you cover the edge of the paper under stitches



Trim the paper back. Making sure to leave enough of an edge to keep the stitches secure.

When mounting the piece in the hoop, The outer hoop will go between the fabric and the paper as shown. Line up the hoop, tighten up the fabric and secure the fabric at the back by your preferred method.



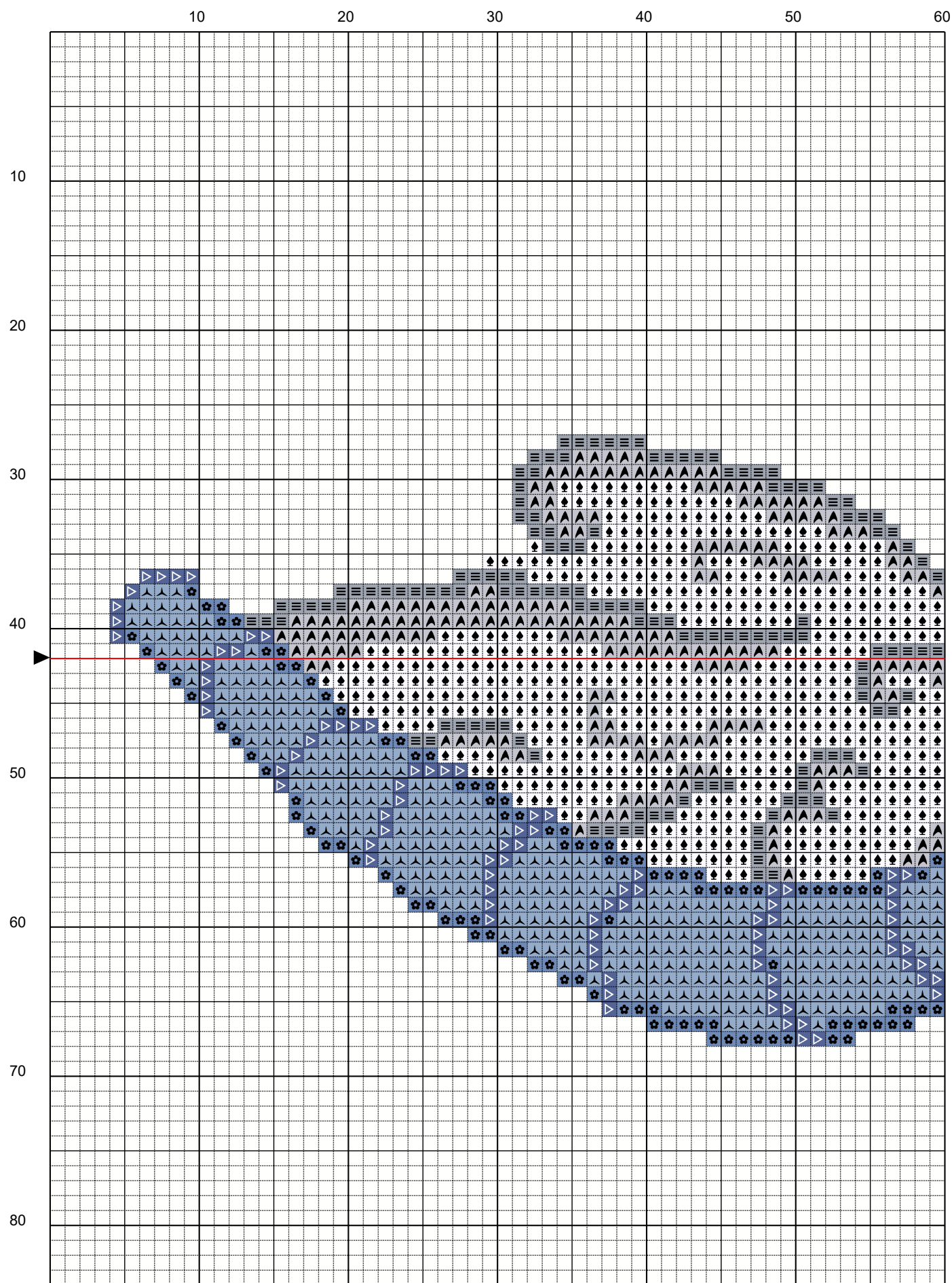
The screw can be hidden behind the paper should you be planning to display it on a tabletop holder. If you're planning on hanging it via the screw, then you can adjust what angle the couple fly in by lightly loosening the screw and turning just the outer hoop. This can be done even after securing the fabric at the back.

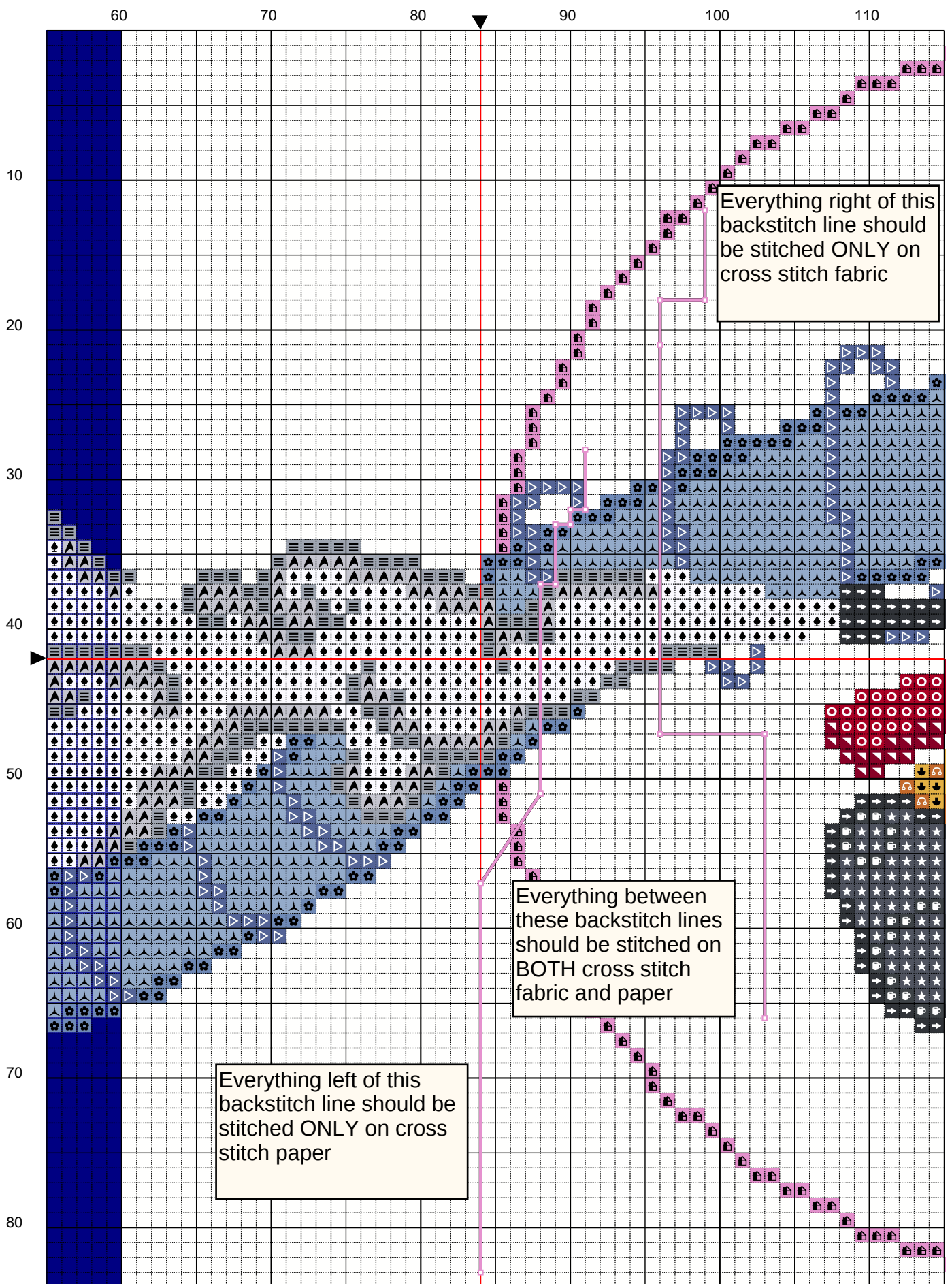
