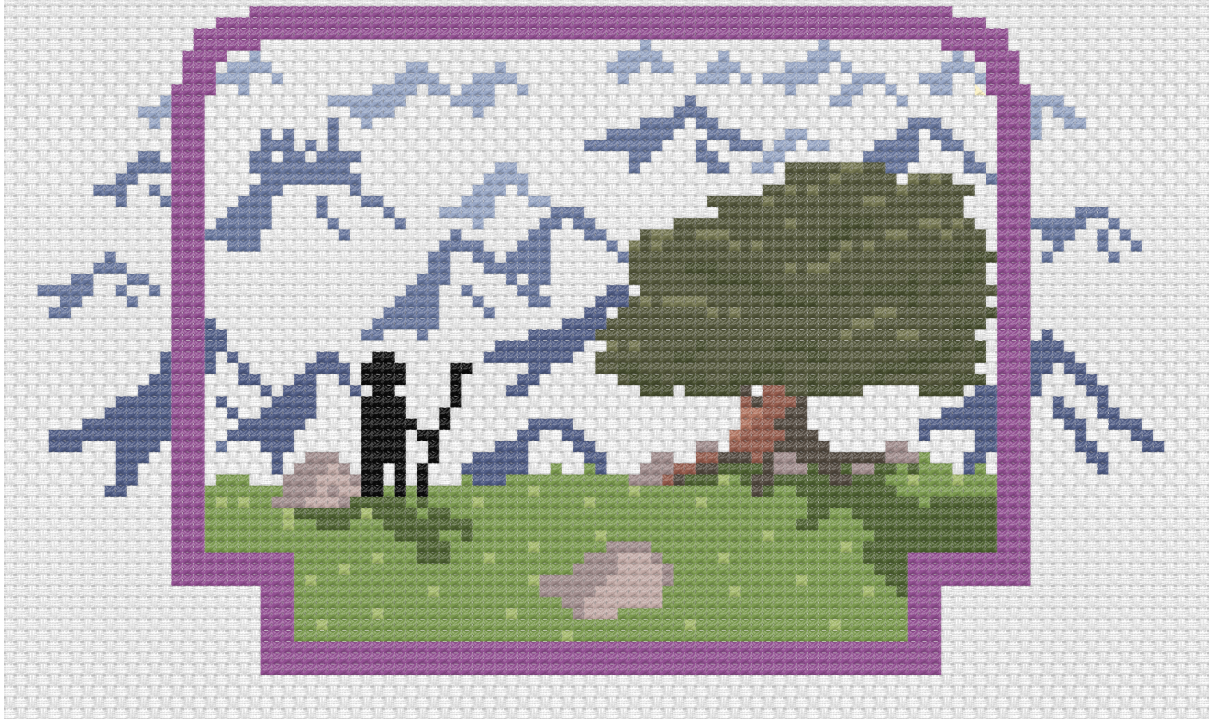

Well, I am sure that I saw something, a creature of similar shape, but not the same as a Dragon.

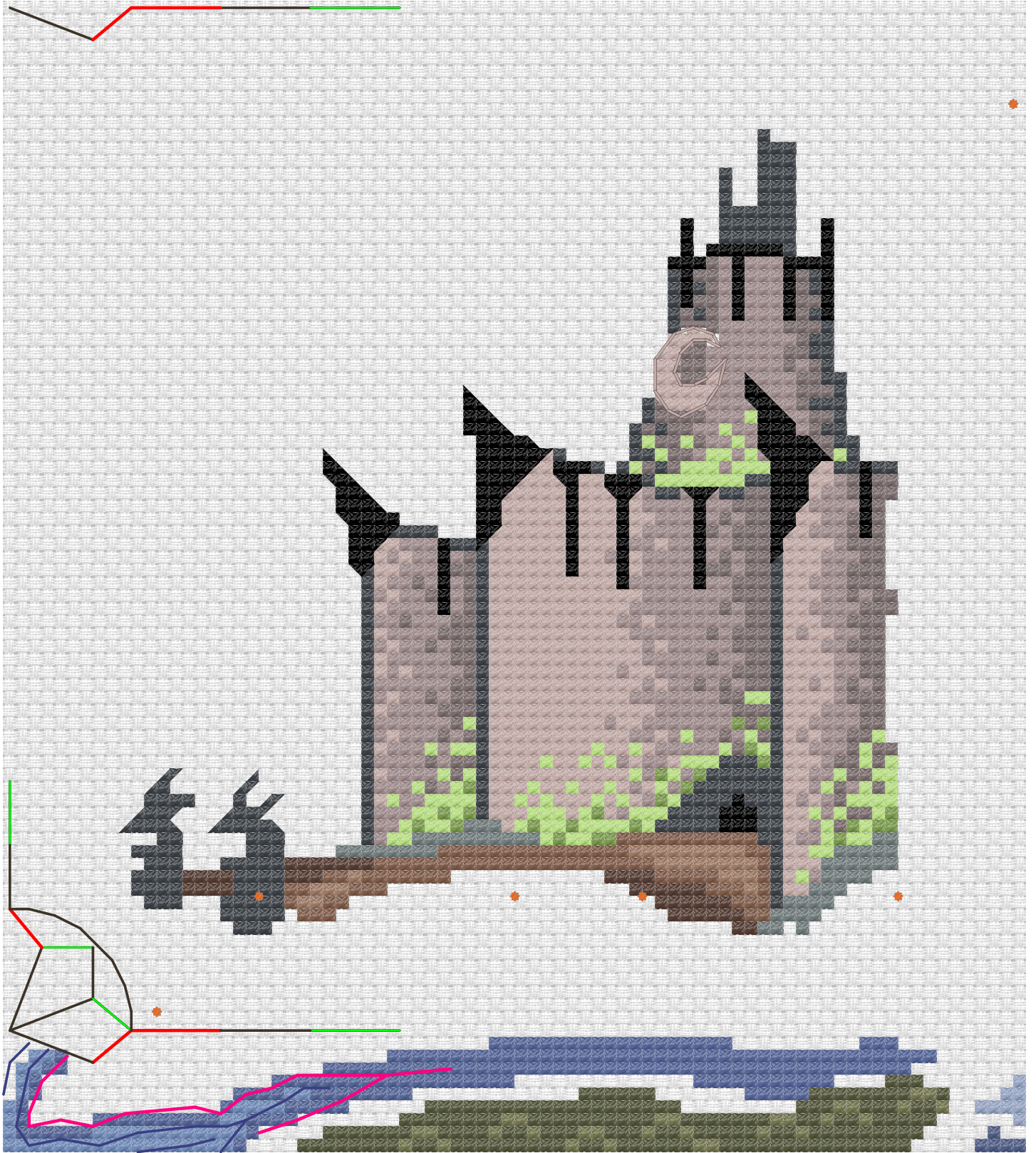

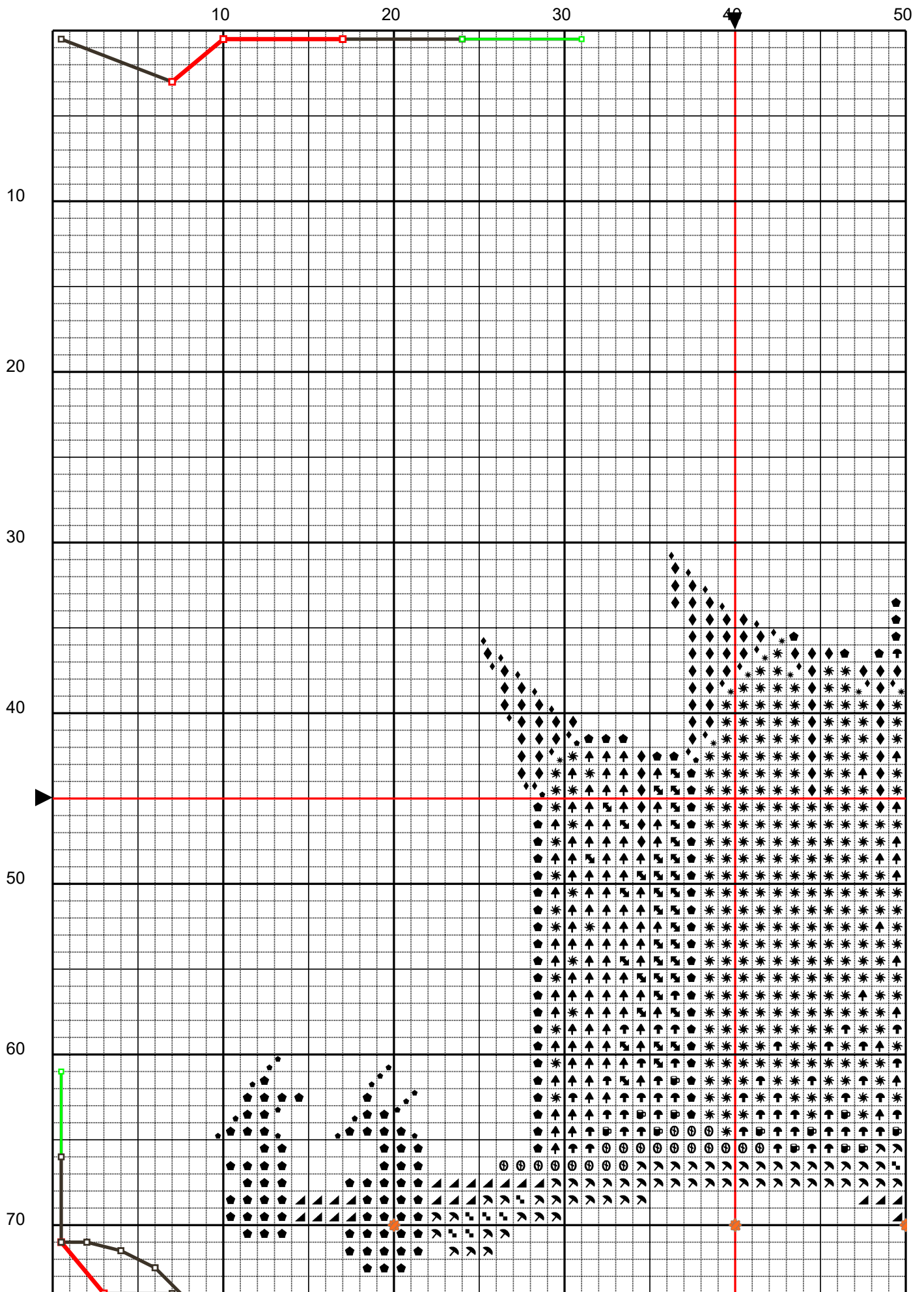

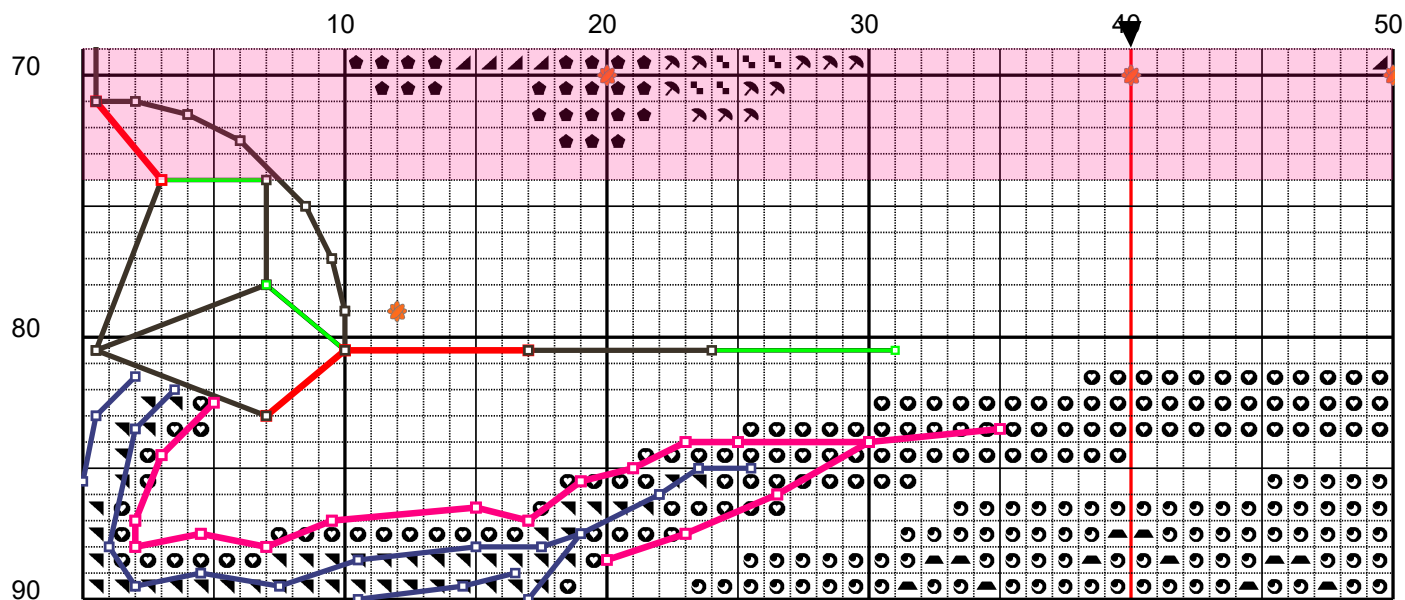
Bilbo, heed my warning, never travel out that way. Stay far away from Minas Morgul, and the whole of Mordor.

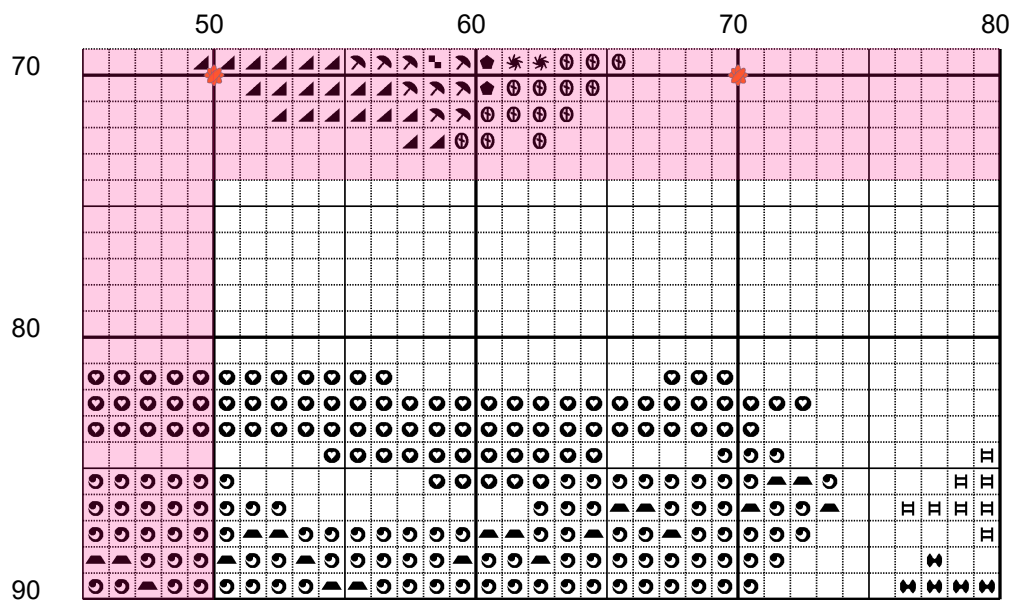

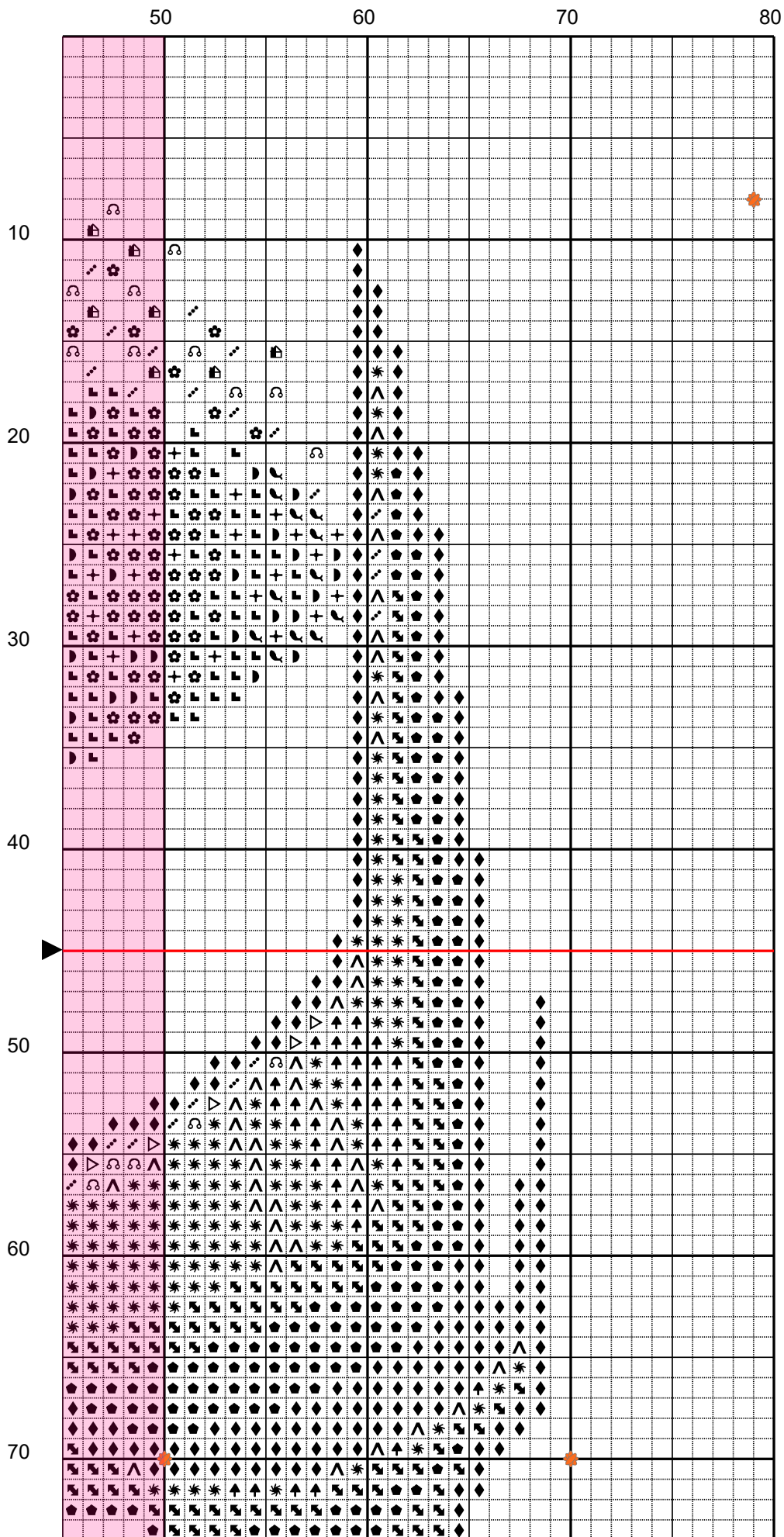
This happened in the mountains surrounding what I later found out to be Mordor. A dark and cursed place Bilbo. Promise me that you will stay away from there.

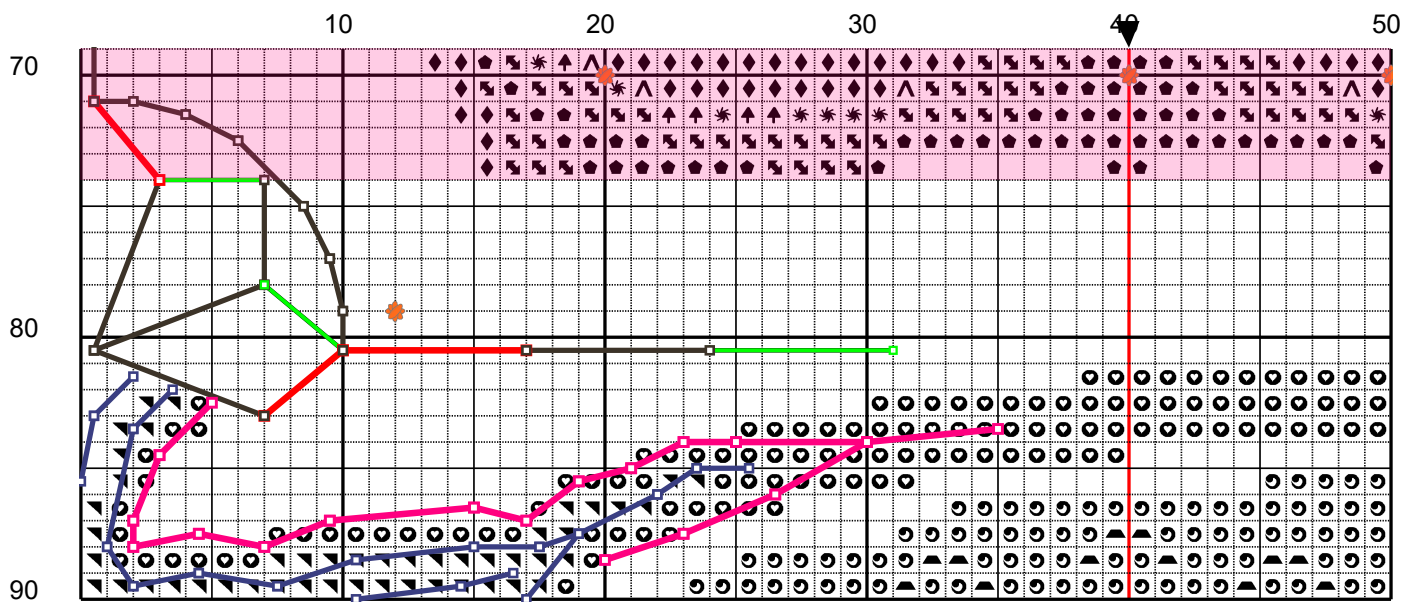

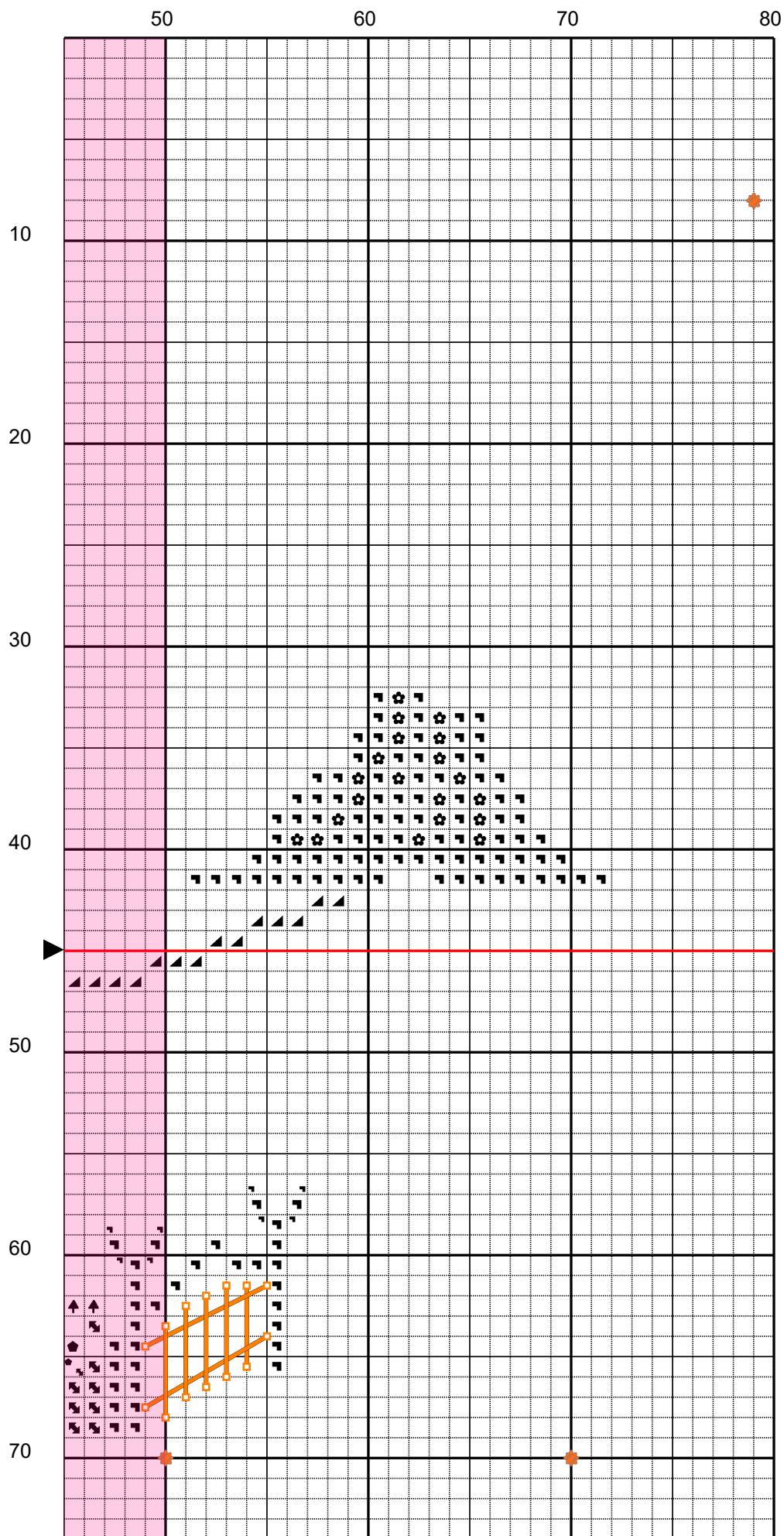
You must avoid these mountains, or at the very least make sure that you are in possession of your sword should you travel there, for the mountains are riddled with orcs and monsters.

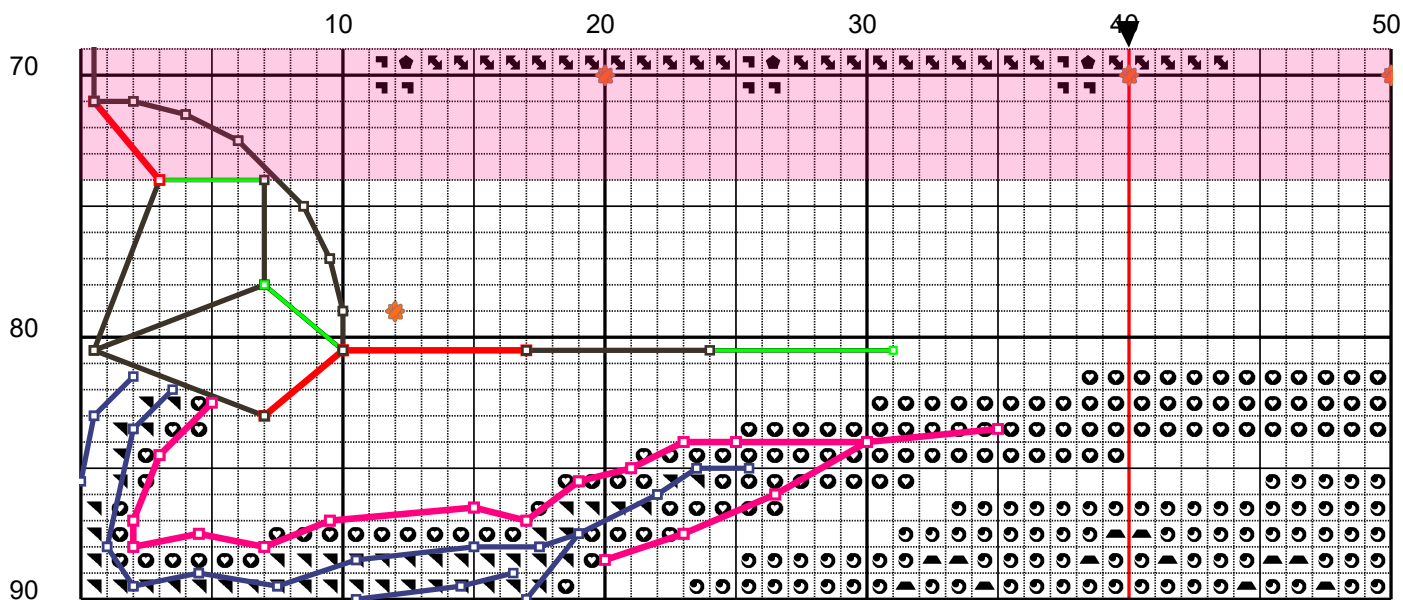

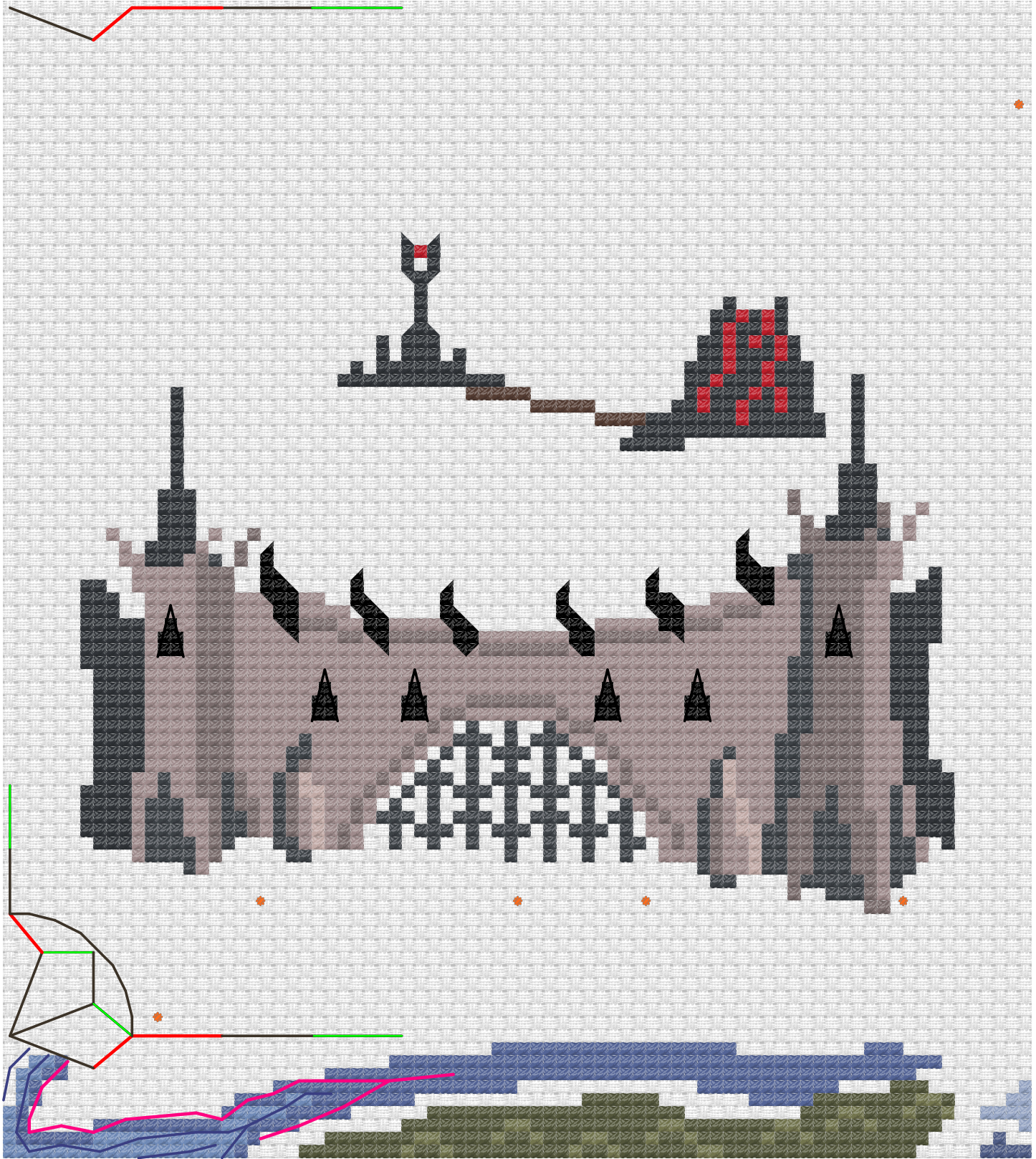
A huge black gate.

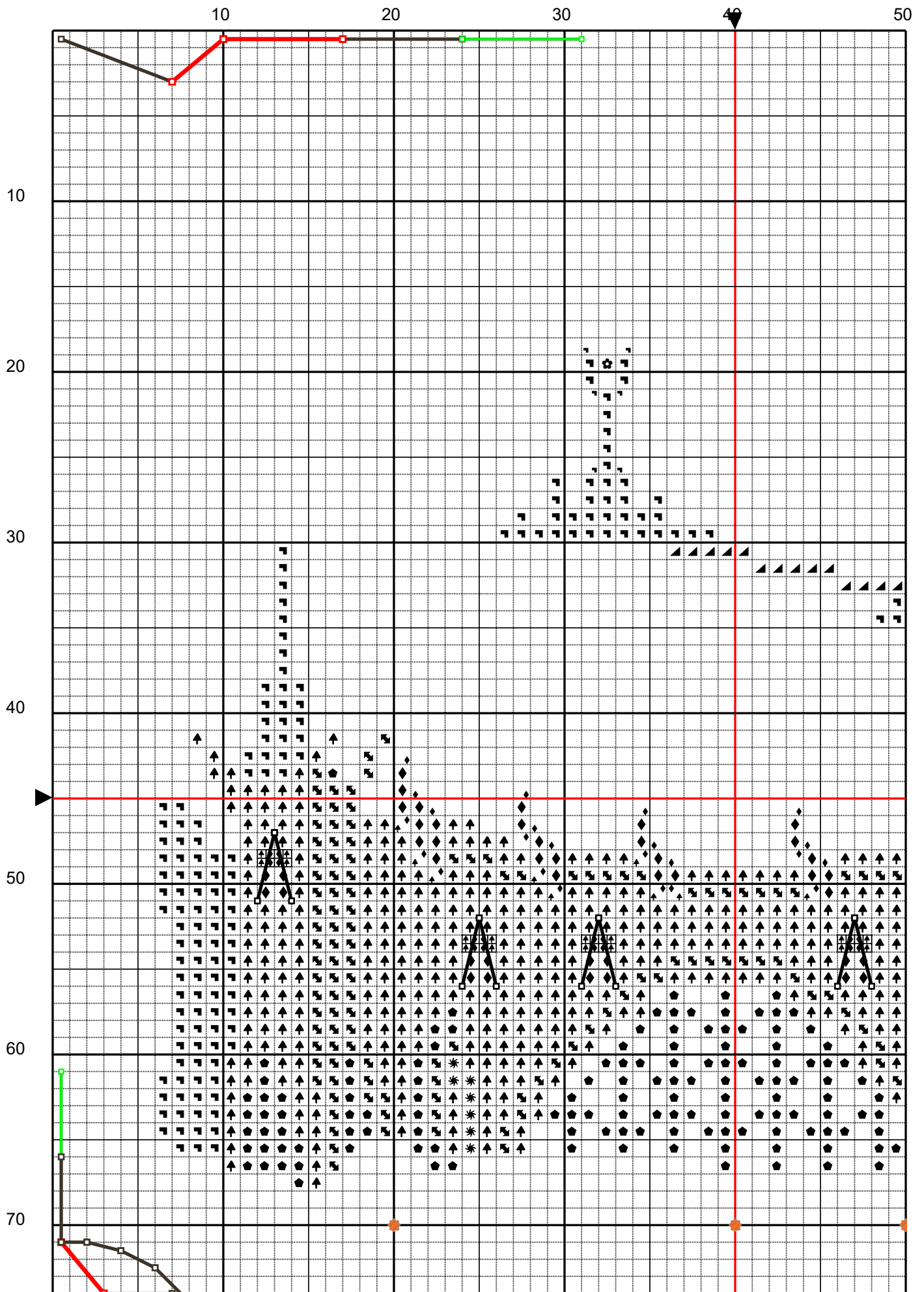

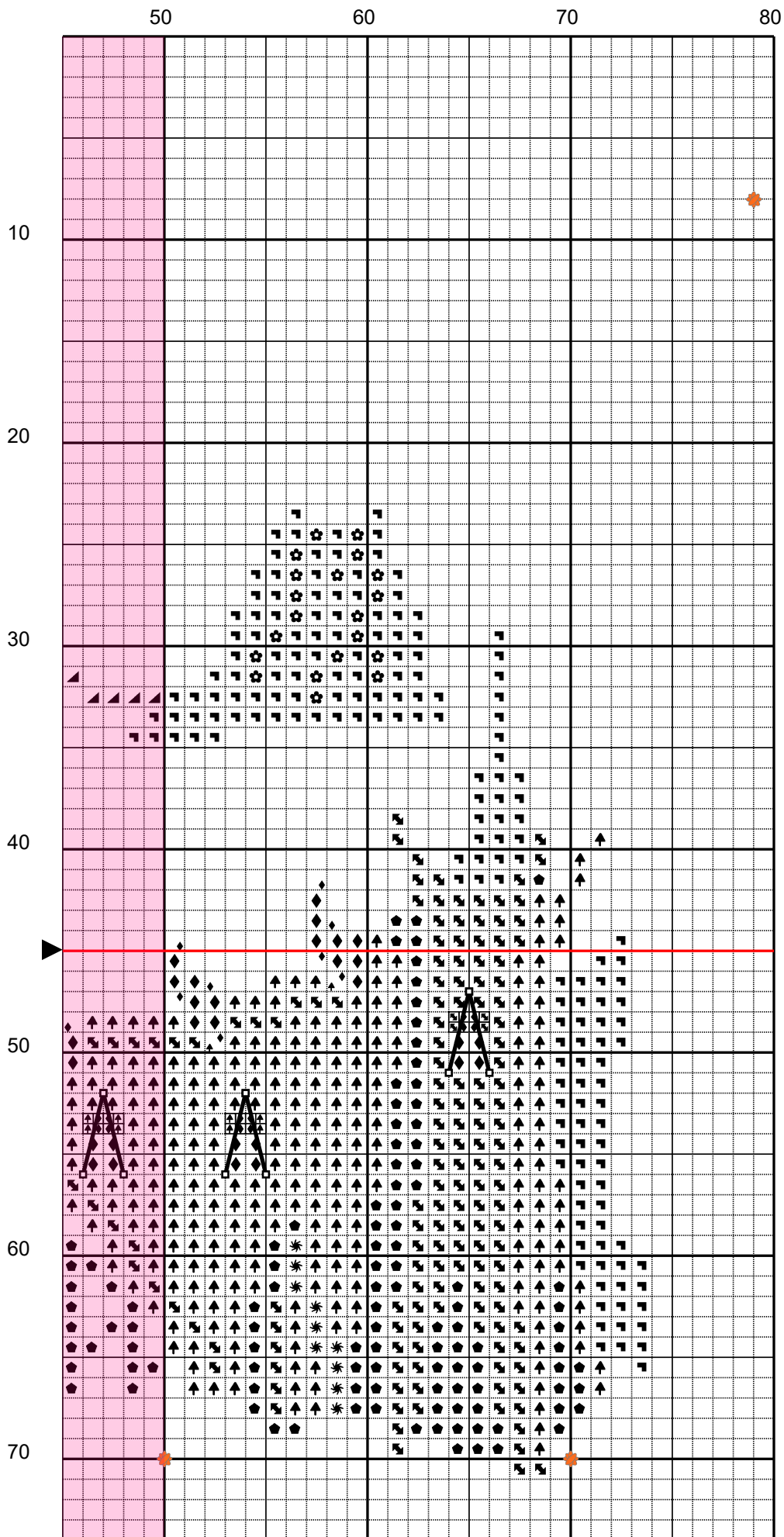
Bilbo, I beg of you, please make sure that you avoid those mountains. I have no idea what force could be held behind those gates, but I am certain that it is evil.

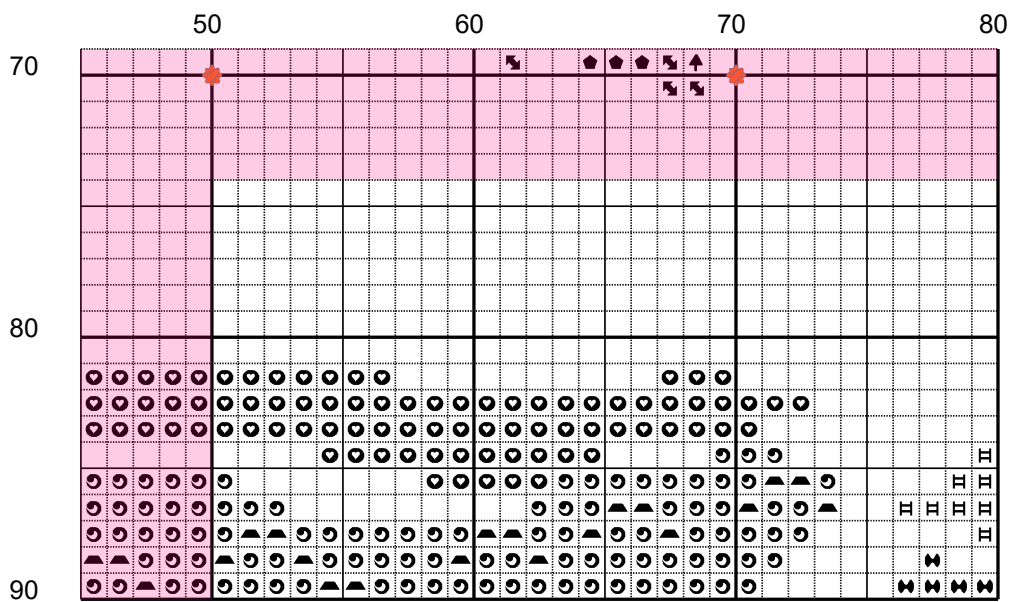

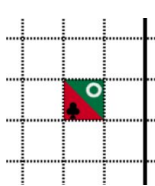
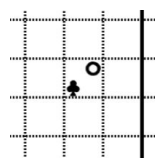
Symbols Explanation

Full Cross Stitch

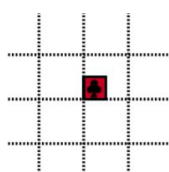
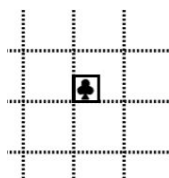


$\frac{3}{4}$ Stitch pair

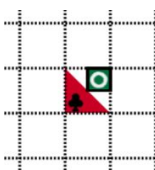
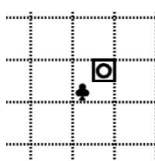


Quarter Stitch

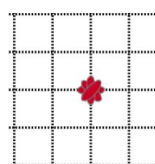
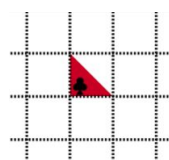
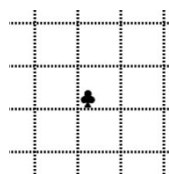
